The death of Mrs. F. E. Welke, treasurer of the Universalist Church in Cortland, on June 2, was a shock to her many friends and represents a loss to the church. She is survived by her husband. The memorial service was conducted by the Rev. William P. Farnsworth. She left a bequest of \$1,000 to be held in trust by the New York State Convention of Universalists with the income going to the church in Cortland.

Memorial resolutions were adopted by the church as follows:

She received the hand of fellowship in the Universalist Church from the Rev. U. S. Milburn in January 6, 1901, and has been always a faithful member. She succeeded George E. Hazzard as treasurer, following his death in 1940, and her work was always efficient.

She carried a high esteem with her fellow-workers in the church and with other friends and she will be greatly missed. To the bereaved family we express our heartfelt sympathy. The resolutions will be spread on the minutes and a copy was sent to the family.
