STANLEY T. WELLS

Stanley T. Wells a native of Fort Plain, died September 9th, in a hospital in Rochester.

He was born in Fort Plain July 1, 1879, son of Myron J. and Alice (Clapp) Wells. He was associated with the Bailey Knitting company at Fort Plain until the dissolution of that concern in 1939. He was secretary of the firm and sales manager of the New York office. At one time, he was secretary to the Hon. Horace White of Syracuse, during the time he was Senator and Lieutenant Governor.

Since 1930 he has been retired from active work; and since 1941 he has been a resident of Rochester where his son was professor of English in the University of Rochester.

Mr. Wells was a member of the Fort Plain Masonic Lodge, and the Fort Plain Universalist church.

Surviving are his wife, the former Lena S. Bailey of Fort Plain; a son, Lieut. Stauring B., somewhere in Italy; a sister, Miss Grace Wells, Fort Plain.

The body was brought to the Gray Funeral Home at Fort Plain, where funeral services were held at 2:30 p.m. Tuesday, with the Rev. Warren B. Lovejoy, pastor of Fort Plain Universalist Church, officiating. Burial in Fort Plain Cemetery.
