HOWARD WENTWORTH

Howard Wentworth, 74, a lifelong resident of Fort Plain died in the Amsterdam City Hospital Monday after a short illness. Mr. Wentworth was born May 16, 1860, the son of Douglas and Harriet Shear Wentworth. For many years he conducted a photograph studio in what is now the Pythian Temple, was a noted trap drummer in the old Fort Plain Band, and for several years was employed as clerk in the Hotel Fort Plain.

The survivors are two sisters, Mrs. Jesse McNeil of Long Beach, Calif., and Mrs. Edwin G. [W.] [Birdella] Wood of Fort Plain; two nieces, Mrs. William [Margaret] Sponable of Utica and Mrs. Harold [Constance] Sponable of Nelliston. The body was brought to this village by B. Gray & Son and the funeral service will be held Friday at 2 P.M., at the Catherine Nellis Memorial chapel. Rev. Gustave Ulrich, pastor of the Universalist church will officiate. Interment will be made in the Spring in the Fort Plain cemetery.
