

[Weston, Harriet Woolley]

Mrs. John Weston, an aged and highly respected Christian woman, died at the home of her son William, about three-fourths of a mile south-east of this village, on Saturday last, after a long and terribly severe illness, that of cancer of the stomach. She was born in Staffordshire, England, in June, 1815, her maiden name being Harriet Woolley. She was married to John Weston Feb. 12th, 1838, and in 1846 they came to this country and settled in this locality, where they have since resided. Five children blessed their union, who with the husband and a very wide circle of friends mourn her demise. The funeral services were held at the house on Sunday afternoon, Rev. O. [Ora] M. Hilton of the Universalist Church, officiating. The interment was made in the cemetery in this village.
