Wheaton

Mrs. Amy A Wheaton died at the advanced age of 85 years, on Thursday night April 10th, at the home of her son S.[Simon] Clifford Wheaton on the Bloodgood place just east of Victor. Her death was the result of a broken limb and serious complications which at her great age she could not combat.

Amy A. Bosworth was born at Taunton, Mass. on April 25, 1834. There her early life was passed and in young womanhood her marriage took place. Not long afterward Mr. and Mrs. Wheaton came to Baptist Hill where they resided for 30 years and where Mr. Wheaton's death occurred many years ago [in 1896]. After his death Mrs. Wheaton lived with her son S. Clifford Wheaton who at that time was a resident of Baptist Hill. The family came to Victor about 20 years ago and they have since resided here.

Mrs. Wheaton is survived by two sons, S. Clifford Wheaton of Victor and J. E. Wheaton of Flint, Mich.; by three sisters, Mrs. Clara Bowen, Mrs. Mary Horton and Mrs. Eliza Pitts, all of Taunton, Mass., and by three brothers, Frank, John, and Philip Bosworth, all of Massachusetts. She also leaves three grandchildren, Mrs. Clara Hyland of Rochester, Alma A. (S\_\_\_s?) of Canandaigua and Frank Wheaton of Victor, and several nieces and nephews.

The funeral services were held at (?) o'clock on Sunday at the Universalist church at Baptist Hill, the pastor, Rev. O. [Otis] F. Alvord officiating. Interment was made in Baptist Hill cemetery beside her husband.

Bristol, N. Y.—Mrs. Amy A. Wheaton, widow of Charles Wheaton, died at the home of her son at Victor on April 10, aged 86 years. Mrs. Wheaton, whose maiden name was Bosworth, was born in Swansea, Mass., coming to the town of Bristol over 60 years ago, where she lived until after Mr. Wheaton's death in 1896. Since then her home had been with her son. She leaves two sons, J. Edwin Wheaton of Flint, Mich., and S. Clifford Wheaton, of Victor; also three sisters and three brothers, all of Taunton, Mass., except John Bosworth, who lives in Phelps. The funeral was held on Sunday at the Universalist church at Bristol, Rev. Alvord officiating. Burial was in Evergreen cemetery.
