MISS LORETTA A. WHEELER
Her Death at Her Home in Alabama After Ten Days' Illness

Oakfield, Jan. 6.—Miss Loretta Anne Wheeler died at 6 o'clock this morning at her home on the Ledge road in Alabama. Ten days ago she took a hard cold, which brought on an attack of asthma, to which she had been subject many years. Death was caused by œdema of the lungs.

Miss Wheeler was born in Barre on February 9, 1857, but her home had been in the house where she died since she was a child. She is survived only by her father, Calvin Wheeler, aged 83. Her mother [Laventia Ferris Wheeler, of Barre,] died on April 8, 1895. She was a member of the Indian Falls Universalist church.

The funeral will be from the home at 10 a.m. on Thursday, the Rev. M. D. Shumway of Le Roy officiating. The burial will be in Shelby.
