World War Veteran Dead

William D. Wheeler, a former member of Company M and a member of W. Mynderse Rice Post, American Legion, died yesterday at his home, 7 Walnut Street. Mr. Wheeler went with Company M to the Mexican Border in 1916 and during the World War was in the service for a short time. He was a member of the Knights of Pythias, the Maccabees and the Painters' Union.

He is survived by his widow, formerly Miss Carrie A. Mosher; one son, Fred L. Wheeler of Auburn; four daughters, Mrs. William Sanderson of Marshfield, Ore., Mrs. Edgar Shrumbsall and the Misses Carrie and Virginia A. Wheeler, all of Auburn, and one sister, Miss Sadie Wheeler of Auburn.

The funeral will be held in the First Universalist Church Saturday afternoon at 3 o'clock with a short prayer at the house at 2:30. Burial will be in Fort Hill.
