Besides her husband, she leaves to mourn her loss, four children—Marsh Whipple, of San Francisco, Cal.; Mrs. Joseph Walzer, of Irondequoit; Mrs. Allison J. Potter and Miss Carrie R. Whipple, of Rochester. The funeral will be held on Saturday afternoon from her late residence, 40 University avenue.
