The death of Mrs. Jennie Pier Whipple, widow of F. Benton Whipple, occurred at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Congdon, near Allen's Lake, after a week's illness.

Mrs. Whipple was born in Springfield Center, November 2, 1852, and spent her early childhood there. She later lived in Brooklyn where she attended Packer Institute.

She was married to Mr. Whipple August 11, 1869. She was a descendant of one of the old families in this vicinity and she was a Charter member of member of Canowauges Chapter D.A.R. She attended the Universalist church in this village until it was dissolved.

She is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Leonard W. Carpenter of Rome.

The funeral was held at the Congdon home Monday afternoon, the Rev. Allen Brown officiating.
