DIED

In this city, November 29, 1865, Susan L., wife of Rev. O. [Obadiah] Whiston, aged (35?). Mrs. Whiston, from her childhood, was a person of rare goodness and intelligence; her whole life was enlightened and blessed by the Universalist faith... Mrs. W. was a frequent contributor to the old "Evangelical Magazine." She was the first Superintendent of the Cooperstown Sabbath School, and at that time wrote the "Infant's Pastime," and soon after, "Lessons for the Infant Mind;" two books which were much needed at the time, and at this day are found in every Sabbath School in the denomination. Mrs. W. was serene and triumphant in her death. Her funeral was attended by Rev. Day K. Lee, and her remains were buried in the Cemetery of Evergreens.
