MRS. BLANCHE S. WHITE

As the result of a five day illness, Mrs. Blanche Spurr White, widow of Walter S. White, died at her home, 60 Elm Street on Saturday. She was 85 years old.

Born in Columbus, New York on July 28, 1862, she spent her early life in that city. On December 18, 1886 she was united in marriage with Mr. White.

Coming to Potsdam in 1908 Mr. White was founder and treasurer of the Phoenix Cheese company, the fore-runner of the Kraft Cheese company. He died in 1914.

Mrs. White is survived by two sons, Frank S. and Donald P. White of Potsdam; five grandchildren; and four great grandchildren.

Mrs. White was a member of the Universalist church in Potsdam and the Nihanawate chapter, Daughters of American Revolution.
