I. J. WHITE DIES; VETERAN MASON

Blossvale—Israel J. White, 94, former Oneida County supervisor and assemblyman, died Wednesday at his home here after a week's illness of pneumonia.

Mr. White operated the Blossvale Canning Company and the Williamstown Canning Company until 1926. He also operated a large farm.

He served as supervisor in 1880 and was a member of the Assembly in 1886. Mr. White was one of the oldest Masons in the state, receiving a 70-year jewel after passing the mark three years ago. He was a member of the Roman Lodge 223, F&AM.

Mr. White was born in the Town of Annsville, son of Israel and Abbie Taft White and resided in that township all his life.

He attended Whitestown Seminary and was a member of the Universalist Church.

Besides his wife, the former Etta O. Ellis, he leaves two daughters, Miss Ruth White, Investigator for the State Welfare Department and Mrs. William MacKenzie, and a son, Leland, both of Blossvale.

Funeral services will be conducted at 3:30 pm. tomorrow in his home with burial in Maple Hill Cemetery, Taberg.
