MRS. JOEL G. WHITE

The death of Louise E., wife of Joel G. White, took place at her home on Chestnut street in Cooperstown, Thursday morning at 2:30 o'clock, following an illness of about four weeks. Mrs. White had been in poor health all summer. She was seventy-two years of age.

Born at Miller's Mills, N.Y. in 1845, she lived there as a girl and afterward moved to Springfield Centre where her marriage to Mr. White took place November 12, 1862. In April, 1871 they moved to Cooperstown where they have since made their home. A faithful worker in the Universalist church for many years, her Christian character impressed all who knew her. Her death will be mourned by a wide circle of friends.

Surviving are the husband and one daughter, Mrs. F. L. Quaif, of Cooperstown.

The funeral services will be held on Saturday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, the Rev. Charles Kramer officiating. Interment in Lakewood Cemetery.
