Her Death Occurred Suddenly in Her New Home on Steuben Street

The death of Mrs. Mary E. Thomas, wife of the late Edwin F. White, occurred suddenly in her home, 1108 Steuben street, about 6 o'clock this morning. She was found dead by Mrs. Winifred Donahue, who lived with her. Coroner Creedon was notified and he called in Doctor Owens, who stated that death was due to heart trouble. The deceased was born in Canada 60 years ago, the daughter of the late Jane E. Graham. When [she was] a child the family moved to Utica, where she received her education in the local public schools. About 25 years ago she suffered with rheumatism and weakening of the heart. She was an invalid up until her death. She was a member of the Universalist Church, and was a Christian woman, beloved by all who knew her. Although confined to her home for many years, she was a patient sufferer, never complaining. She is survived by one son, David F. White; one brother, William A. Graham; and one sister, Mrs. Edward Shultus; one granddaughter, Marjorie White, and many nephews and nieces, all of this city.
