DORA ESTELLA WHITWOOD

Mrs. Frank E. Whitwood, who suffered an acute illness a week ago Saturday evening, and was taken to the Cuba Hospital by Dr. Webster, the following morning, died Friday, at 11:20 A. M. Mrs. Whitwood had been in an unconscious condition for several days, but previous to her death had shown signs of recovery, regaining partial consciousness and recognizing her husband and children who called on her, later in the week.

Dora Estella Cady, daughter of Burr H. and Lucy Davis Cady, the wife of Frank Eugene Whitwood, was born on September 15th, 1873. Besides her husband, she is survived by seven children, three step-children, four brothers and four sisters, and nine grand-children. The children are as follows: Mrs. Rose Ellison of Cuba, Mr. Earl Baker of Belfast and Mr. Ernest Baker of this place (by former marriage); Mrs. Orval Warner of West Clarksville; Allen, Arthur, and Miss Etta Whitwood, all at home. The three step-sons are Deo Whitwood of Dansville, Walter Whitwood of Westfield, and Merle Whitwood of Whittier, California.

The four brothers and sisters, all of whom attended the funeral, are Mrs. Mary Knapp, Mrs. Wm. Herrington, Mrs. George Gunn, Mrs. Harvey McMIndes, Mr. George Cady, Mr. Raymond Cady, Mr. Arthur Cady, all of Troupsburg, N.Y., and Mr. William Cady of Mansfield, Pa.

The funeral was held at the Universalist Church of this place at 1 p.m. on Monday. Rev. Miss [Clara] Morgan, pastor of the Universalist church of Hornell, officiated. Burial was at Mt. Hope.

The funeral was largely attended. Many floral offerings and the large gathering of friends and relatives attested the beautiful life of this loving wife, mother and friend, who so peacefully passed from earthly suffering.
