Mr. Wiles, whose illness we had previously noticed, died at his home in this town last Saturday. His only surviving brother is Mr. Jacob Wiles, who resides at Brookman's Corners. Many years ago the subject of this sketch married Catherine Dillenbeck, a sister of Baltus and Henry Dillenbeck, and their children, who are well and favorably known to all the residents of this town, are Adam, George, Lester, Mrs. Peter Moyer, Mrs. Jerry Moyer, of Glen, Mrs. William Shaul, Mrs. Henry Walster, and Mrs. Addison Bauder. Mr. Wiles was a man who, through his whole life, maintained the respect of his neighbors and acquaintances. His views of honesty and uprightness were rigid, and he lived up to them. The funeral occurred on Tuesday last and was attended by more people than any similar occasion in a long time. Rev. L. J. [Luther Jacobs] Fletcher, D.D., [a Universalist], officiated.
