—Entered into rest, April 28, 1898, after a protracted illness, at his home in this village, Monroe Wilkinson, aged 57 years. Committal services were held from the church on May 1st, Rev. Daniel Ballou [Universalist], of Utica, officiating. A widow [Sally Williams Wilkinson], two sons, one brother [Asel] and two sisters, are left to mourn their loss. Deceased had kept a hotel in this village for a number of years and had hosts of friends, an unusually large number being at the church to pay their last respects, so many in fact that the church could not accommodate them. Rev. Ballou preached an eloquent discourse from I Corinthians 15-35.
