Mrs. Clarence Williams

Mrs. Erma C. Williams, 61, widow of Clarence Williams, died at 11:40 o'clock last night (March 15, 1944) at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Charles Cone of the Sweetland road, Stafford. She had been in failing health for 1½ years and in serious condition for four weeks.

Born at Bethany on April 24, 1882, Mrs. Williams was a daughter of Frank and Nellie Hawks Pinney. She had spent her entire lifetime in Genesee County. She was a member of the Le Roy Universalist Church and the Pavilion Grange. On July 20, 1904, she was married at Roanoke to Mr. Williams who died on March 16, 1926.

Besides her daughter, Mrs. Williams is survived by two sons, Louis H. Williams of Stafford and Elbert C. Williams in the United States Navy on duty in the Pacific; another daughter, Mrs. Raymond Roberts of Toledo, O.; Coradon E. Pinney of Gainesville, and Fred H. Pinney of Stafford; two sisters, Mrs. Nellie Wright and Mrs. Agnes Legg of Stafford, and 15 grandchildren.

Funeral services for Mrs. Williams will be held at 2:30 o'clock Saturday afternoon from the home of her daughter where she died. The Rev. Harry Wright [Universalist] of Bristol will officiate. Interment will be in Stafford Cemetery.
