Death of Mrs. Everett Willis.

Mrs. Everett Willis died at her home on Watrous street in this village last Saturday night, after a brief illness, aged 64 years.

Cora A. Bolton was a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Jasper M. Bolton and was born in the town of Leicester on Feb. 19th, 1855. She was one of a family of five children—three sons and two daughters, two of whom—James and Margaret—died in childhood¹.

Funeral services were held at the family residence on Watrous street at 3 o'clock on Tuesday afternoon, conducted by her pastor, Rev. Clara Morgan, with interment at Hope Cemetery.
