GEORGE G. WILSON DIES AT BROWNVILLE

George G. Wilson, aged 66, died at his home in Brownville on Saturday evening about 7 o'clock, of a stroke. He had been ill but a short time.

He was born at Theresa, May 3, 1858, son of the late George and Alameda Richmond Wilson. When he was 16 years of age he moved to Natural Bridge where he resided until about 10 years ago, when he moved to Brownville. His wife Julia Rice Wilson died at Natural Bridge about 18 years ago [in 1906]. He was a papermaker and was employed at a Brownville mill.

He is survived by one daughter, Mrs. T. E. [Blanche] Evans of Utica, one son, Clavin [Calvin] G. Wilson, and three sisters, Mrs. Alice Gates, of this city; Mrs. Harriet [? illegible] of [? illegible] and Miss Clara Wilson of Natural Bridge.

The funeral will be held privately from the home in Brownsville Tuesday afternoon at 2. Rev. Harry Westbrook Reed, pastor of All Souls [Universalist] church of this city, will officiate. Interment will be made at Natural Bridge [in Hillside Cemetery].
