MRS. MARIANNE LARRABEE WILSON

Widow of Lorenzo Wilson Died at Camp on Lake Cayuga on June 19

Mrs. Marianne Larrabee Wilson, aged 79 years, who was born at Almond, N.Y. died June 19th, 1919 of apoplexy while at camp on Lake Cayuga where with her daughter, Mrs. Wells, she had gone for an outing. She was ill twelve days.

Deceased was the widow of Lorenzo Wilson who died Dec. 14, 1909.

In company with her parents Mrs. Wilson came to Whitesville when about five years of age, living with them until her marriage after which she and her husband moved to the farm bearing his name which is next to the George W. Forsyth farm on Peach Hill. Since Mr. Wilson's death she had made her home with her daughter, Mrs. Wells.

Besides a brother, Marcelle Larrabee of Emporium, Pa., deceased is survived by one son, Rene Wilson of Lexington, Va.; Mrs. Wells of Auburn, N.Y.; a granddaughter Miss Florence Wells of Washington, D.C.; and a foster daughter, Mrs. Cyrus Moses of this village from whose home the funeral was held Monday afternoon at 3 o'clock, Rev. C. [Clark] L. Paddock [Universalist] officiating. Burial in Rural Cemetery.

Mrs. Wilson was by faith a Universalist but not affiliated with the church. She had many relatives and friends in and about Whitesville.
