MRS. LAURA WINDECKER

Little Falls—Mrs. Laura Windecker died Aug. 28, 1946 in the local hospital, where she had been a patient since she suffered a heart attack Aug. 26 at the home of her daughter, Mrs. John Daniels, Jacksonburg.

Born Oct. 16, 1879 in the Town of Fairfield, she was the daughter of Willard and Delight Ransom Keller. On Mar. 7, 1900 she was married to Frank Windecker, who died in 1937.

She was a member of St. Paul's Universalist Church, the local DAR chapter, the OES and the Little Falls Grange.

Surviving besides her daughter Mrs. Daniels are a son, John Windecker, Whitesboro, and a brother Albert Keller, Middleville.

The Rev. Howard Gilman, pastor of the local Universalist Church, will conduct funeral services at 2 p.m. tomorrow from the home of Mrs. Daniels in Jacksonburg. Burial will be in Church St. Cemetery.
