RITES TOMORROW FOR B. C. WIRES.

Herkimer—The funeral of Bloomfield C. Wires, 85, who died Feb. 8, 1940, will be conducted tomorrow at 3 p.m. from the Taylor Funeral home, 409 N. Prospect St. The Rev. S. D. Butler, Russia, supply pastor of the First Universalist Church, Herkimer, will officiate. Interment will be in Oak Hill Cemetery.

Mr. Wires, for many years superintendent of desk construction at the Standard Furniture Company, and superintendent of the Universalist Sunday School, died in the home of his grandson, Edwin B. Wires, (44\_?) N. Bellinger St., after a long illness.

He was in the employ of the desk company for more than 35 years before he retired about 10 years ago. He was a past master of Herkimer Lodge 428, F&AM, a member of the lodge's board of trustees and a member of the building committee when the Masonic Temple was built in 1918.

In addition to serving as superintendent of the Sunday School, he was a trustee of that church and for several years was president of the congregation.

Mr. Wires was born in Mohawk, son of Perry G. and Nancy [Harter] Wires. He came to Herkimer when a young man and on Jan. 1, 1880, married Miss Ida Morris.

Besides his wife he leaves a son, Leland C. Wires, Little Falls; two daughters, Mrs. H. E. Clark, Schenectady, [and] Lillian, Scarsdale; and a sister, Mrs. Herman Cristman, Herkimer.
