The funeral of Mrs. Leland C. Wires will be held Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock from her late home in Henry street, the Rev. Charles E. Bingham officiating. Interment will be made in Oak Hill Cemetery.

The death of Mrs. Elizabeth Whitmore, wife of Leland C. Wires, occurred yesterday at her home in Henry street. Mrs. Wires, though in ill health for some time, had strength to be about and had only been confined to the house a few days, and her death coming so suddenly caused a shock in the village where she was born and where she had always resided. She was 33 years old and was the daughter of William Whitmore, late of this village, and was a member of the Universalist Church and active in its work when health permitted. She was also affiliated with Myrtle Chapter, O.E.S. and was a young woman well and popularly known by many friends who highly regarded her and by whom her presence will be regretfully missed. The sympathy of all will be extended to surviving relatives, who, beside the husband, are her mother, Mrs. Anna Whitmore, a sister, Miss Anna Whitmore of this village, and a brother, Harold F. Whitmore of Flint, Mich.
