Mrs. Ida Wires Dies, Former Resident Here

Mrs. Ida A. Wires, widow of the late Bloomfield C. Wires, died last night at the home of her daughter, Mrs. H. E. Clark, Schenectady. Born Oct. 30, 1873¹ in Eaton Bush, Mrs. Wires was the daughter of the late Thomas and Diantha Morris. On Dec. 31, 1873, she was married to Bloomfield Wires and came to Herkimer where they resided for many years. Like her husband, who was trustee and president of the Universalist church, Mrs. Wires was active in that church, particularly in the Ladies' Aid society. She also affiliated with Myrtle Chapter OES. She leaves one son, William C. Wires, Little Falls; two daughters, Mrs. W. J. Edmonds, Scarsdale, and Mrs. H. E. Clark, Schenectady, and four grandchildren. The funeral will be at 2 p.m. Friday from the Taylor Funeral Home, with Rev. Herbert W. Haynes, Universalist minister, officiating. Burial will be in Oak Hill Cemetery.
