Bridgewater, Jan. 15—Mrs. Adelia A. Cummings, widow of Charles Wiser, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. William [Julia] Matteson, Saturday. She was born in Deerfield July 21, 1820, and her life was spent in that vicinity. Her husband, Charles Wiser, died 15 years ago [1877], after which she left the farm in Deerfield and went to reside in Poland. For the past few years she had lived winters with her only [surviving] child, Mrs. William Matteson, of this village, and the summers Mrs. Matteson spent with her at Poland, so that she might live in her own home. Besides the daughter, Mrs. Wiser leaves two grandchildren, Charles Matteson of this village and Mrs. Wilfred Gilbert of Herkimer and five great-grandchildren. Mrs. Wiser had taken an interest in the Universalist Church all her life.
