Mrs. Adelia Witherstine

Mohawk—A life-long resident of the Towns of Herkimer and German Flatts, Mrs. Adelia Witherstine, 86, died at her home, 78 E. Main St., after a long illness, Saturday, June 5, 1943.

Mrs. Witherstine was born in 1857 at Kast Bridge, a daughter of the late John S. and Elizabeth Fulmer Cristman.

In 1879 she married Edward Witherstine as Middleville. Mr. Witherstine died about 29 years ago in Mohawk. Mrs. Witherstine spent about 45 years in Herkimer, living in the home they built on Eastern Ave. Mrs. Witherstine was a member of the Universalist church.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Frank Jackson, Mohawk; several nieces and nephews. The funeral was conducted Tuesday, June 8, 1943, from her late home, with the Rev. Harold Hynes, Universalist minister officiating. Interment was in Oak Hill cemetery.
