In earlier life, he was a member of the Winning Hose company, the Fort Plain band and the Bohemian Club.

He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. J. Willard [Margaret] Sponable, Fort Plain, and Mrs. Harold F. [Constance] Sponable, Nelliston; one sister, Miss Rexa Wood, Fort Plain; three grandchildren, Mrs. Otto W. L. Stahler, Fort Plain, Mrs. James M. Bailey, Sidney, and Miss Kay Sponable, Nelliston, and three great-grandchildren, Craig and Scott Stahler, both of Fort Plain, and Brian Bailey, Sidney. [His wife died Feb. 1, 1955 at the Canajoharie Convalescent Home].

Funeral services were held from the Gray Funeral Home at 2 p.m. Tuesday with the Rev. James Alcock, pastor of the Universalist Church of the Messiah, Fort Plain, officiating.

Interment was made in the Wood family vault in the Fort Plain Cemetery.
