—Justus Woodard died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Charles H. Dodge, in Earlville, Saturday, Aug. 3. The deceased was the son of Joseph and Polly Woodard, and was born in the town of Brookfield, July 26, 1825. His early life was spent in Tallette. He was married in 1849 to Theda Sholes, but their married life was short as his wife died in 1850. In 1855 he was married to Clarissa Persons, and 36 years of their married life were passed in New Berlin. Last December they went to Earlville. He leaves a widow and one daughter, Mrs. C. H. Dodge of Earlville, with whom they had lived for the past few months. Funeral exercises were conducted by Rev. Daniel Ballou of Utica [a Universalist] Monday, Aug. 5. Interment at New Berlin.
