Lewis Woodcock, 83, Dies After Long Illness in Falls

Seneca Falls, Mar. 16—Lewis E. Woodcock, 83, of 60 Mynderse St., died yesterday in Seneca Falls hospital after a long illness.

Funeral services will be held Saturday at 2 p.m. in the Sanderson funeral home, 32 State St. Officiating will be Rev. William Metz, pastor of Universalist church, Central Square.
