RITES HELD FOR MR. WOODHEAD, POWER OFFICIAL

Funeral services for Albert N. Woodhead, 55, director of personnel and labor relations for the Niagara-Mohawk Power Corp., who died suddenly at his Delmar home Sunday afternoon, were held at the Tebbutts Funeral Home, Albany, at 9:30 a.m. today. Burial will take place at Evergreen Cemetery, Watertown<sup>1</sup>, tomorrow morning.

Mr. Woodhead, his company said, had conducted week-long labor relations sessions in Syracuse and it is believed that the strain had resulted in a collapse which occurred Friday at the home of his daughter in Hilton. He was removed to his Delmar home where he died.

Mr. Woodhead was a former reporter for the Watertown Times and a graduate of St. Lawrence University. He had been associated with the power corporation since 1926, his work being primarily in the publicity and advertising departments until 1944 when he became director of personnel and labor relations.

He was an alumni and trustee of St. Lawrence University and also a trustee of the university's theological school. He is a past president of the Albany YMCA and president of the board of the Albany Unitarian-Universalist Church.

He is survived by his wife; his mother, Mrs. Florence F. Woodhead of Albany; two daughters, Mr. Louis R. DeRitter of Hilton and Miss Anne Woodhead of Delmar, and a son A.1.C. Albert A Woodhead of Lackland Air Base, Tex.
