—The residents of this village were saddened on Tuesday of last week to learn that Mrs. Mary Woodworth had passed away.—She had only been ill a few days and many of her friends did not learn of her sickness, and her death came like a bolt out of a clear sky. Mr. Woodworth and her son, Louis, who were at home with her, did not realize that she was fatally ill. Her funeral was held from her late home on Saturday at 1 o'clock, Rev. H. [Herbert] P. Morrell [Universalist] of Canton conducting the services. She leaves besides her husband [Francis], two sons, Louis and Harry; two sisters, Mrs. John Hunter of Rural Hill and Mrs. Florence Garlock of Scottville, Mich.; four brothers, Fred, Talcott George and Walter [surname Read], all of Scottville, and all of whom came to attend the funeral except George. Mrs. Woodworth was 61 years of age, a kind, devoted wife and mother, a good friend and neighbor, and will be greatly missed in the village and in the church, as well as in the home that is left desolate by her passing. The interment was at Smithville.
