MRS. MARY WOOLEVER

Dolgeville—Mrs. Mary Woolever, 79, died Feb. 8, 1946 in the home of her son, Roy, 23 S. Helmer Ave., following a stroke which she suffered seven days ago.

Mrs. Woolever was born May 17, 1866 in Stratford, the daughter of Alfred and Charlotte Cady, and had resided in Dolgeville 33 years, having come here from Salisbury. She was a member of the Universalist Church and a former president of the Ladies Aid Society. On Mar. 4, 1884 she married Willis Woolever, who died in 1936.

Surviving besides the son with whom she lived, are three other sons, Jesse and John, Salisbury Center, and Earl, Freeport, Pa.; one daughter, Mrs. Floyd Shepard, Oneida; three sisters, Mrs. Daisy Howard, Salisbury Center, Mrs. William Bowly, Stratford; Mrs. Helena Sweeney, Rockford, Ill., four grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. tomorrow in the home of her son, Roy, 23 S. Helmer Ave., the Rev. C. A. Moulton of the Universalist Church, officiating. Interment will be in the Dolgeville Cemetery.
