MRS. NETTIE WOOLWORTH

Mrs. Nettie W. Woolworth, aged 77, of Mount Clemens, Mich., and Cooperstown, died early Monday morning at her Cooperstown home.

She was born May 17, 1877, in Fort Plain, daughter of Alphonso and Mary (Farley) Walrath. She was married to Herbert Grant Woolworth in 1910 [on June 21] in Fort Plain.

Mrs. Woolworth was a member of the Universalist Church and of the Daughters of [the] American Revolution.

She leaves two sisters, Mrs. Waldo Auger, Orlando, Fla., and Mrs. Charles C. Miller, Cooperstown; several nieces, nephews and cousins.
