END COMES SUDDENLY TO ANSEL E. WRIGHT Former Webster Supervisor Known Throughout County [abridged]

Ansel E. Wright, president of the Monroe County Pioneers Association and known throughout the county for his wit, died suddenly yesterday morning at his home in Park avenue, aged 68 years. He was out for an automobile ride on Monday. Mr. Wright was born on May 2, 1848 in Webster. In 1871 he married Hannah E. Dresser, of Adams Basin.

In 1891 Mr. Wright was elected to the Board of Supervisors' and ex-Supervisors' Association. One of his delights was to conduct the annual picnic of the Pioneers' association at Manitou Beach.

Mr. Wright was a past master of the Webster Lodge, F. & A.M. and was also a Royal Arch Mason. He was for several years superintendent of the Universalist Sunday-school and was a member of Webster Grange. Besides his wife and daughter, Edith Ann Wright, he leaves two brothers, Elwyn Wright of Cortland and Dufay Wright of Webster.

The funeral services will be held on Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Webster Baptist church. There will be a Masonic service. Interment will be made in Webster Union cemetery.
