Our Outlook expresses the deep sympathy of all our people for her husband and mother, and her sisters Edna and Inez. Mrs. Wright leaves her little son Graham in hands well fortified to care for him and cherish the recollection of his mother. Rev. Mr. [William Wallace] Rose conducted the private services, and the body was laid away at Mt. Hope [on March 28].
