In the death of Mrs. Charles S. Wright, which occurred at her home, Sunday afternoon, Webster loses one of her oldest residents. Mrs. Wright's maiden name was Sabrina Robb and she was born here in the north part of this town in 1820. The town was then called North Penfield. She was married to Charles S. Wright in 1843, making sixty-three years that they have journeyed through life together. Mrs. Wright leaves three sons, Ansel [born on 2 May 1848] and DuFay [born on 14 Sep 1857] of this place, and E. [Elwyn] Corwin [born on 22 Sep 1850]<sup>1</sup> of Cortland; nine grandchildren and her aged husband to mourn her loss. Mr. and Mrs. Wright were charter members of the Grange and have a host of friends all through the county who will sympathize with the family in their affliction. Mrs. Wright suffered a stroke of paralysis the 26th of last December, from which she never rallied, and had been a sufferer ever since. The funeral was held from the home, Tuesday afternoon, Rev. A. [Artemus] L. Partridge of the Universalist church, of which Mrs. Wright was a life long member, officiated.
