DEATH OF MRS. HANNAH M. YOUNG

Mrs. Hannah M. Young, widow of the late Burrage W. Yale died yesterday at the home of her son, C. LeRoy Yale, at 601 North Main street. She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. James Young and was born August [29?], 1836 in the town of Herkimer, and September 14, 1865 was united to Burrage W. Yale and lived until 1890 in the town of Fairfield, removing to Salisbury Center, where Mr. Yale died October 9, 1900. The deceased came to visit her son, C. LeRoy Yale in 1910 and was stricken with paralysis and never recovered her strength, and in her sickness being most patient and cheerful. She is survived by two sisters, Mrs. Eliza Hazlett of Tripoli, Ia., and Mrs. Mary Boyd of Joliet, Ill., and the son above mentioned; by a stepdaughter, Mrs. Mina L. Young, and a stepson, J. O. Yale of Middleville, and an adopted daughter, Mrs. Etta B. Rumsey of Rochester. The remains will be taken to Salisbury Center for the funeral service to be held from the Universalist Church at 11:45 tomorrow morning, the Rev. Charles E. Bingham officiating. Interment will be made in the Tuttle Cemetery at Salisbury Center.
