Roy H. Youker Dies at 75 Yrs.

Roy H. Youker, 75, of Oppenheim, died Sunday evening in Little Falls Hospital, after an illness of about two weeks.

Mr. Youker was born Aug. 19, 1887 in Oppenheim, son of Willard J. and Florence L. Vedder Youker. He was a life-long resident of Oppenheim, having been a farmer all his adult life.
