Willard Judd Youker

Dolgeville, July 7.—Willard Judd Youker, 77, well known, lifelong resident of the town of Oppenheim, died at 11 o'clock Tuesday night at his home on the Inghams Mills-Crum Creek road. Death was due to complications.

Mr. Youker was born in Oppenheim on April 5, 1866, a son of William H. and Catherine Vedder Youker. He conducted a large farm and was a member of the Modern Woodmen.

On October 5, 1886, he was married to Miss Florence L. Vedder, who survives, together with three sons, Ray, H. Fay and John H., all of Oppenheim; one sister, Mrs. Adelia Timmerman, Snells Bush, 17 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held privately Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the late home with Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton, of the local Universalist church officiating. Burial will be in Inghams Mills cemetery.
