A gloom was cast over the entire community at Schuyler Lake on Tuesday when it was reported that Mrs. Fred [Grace Hecox] Young had passed away at the Thanksgiving Hospital in Cooperstown after an operation for a tumor.

For the past month she has been very ill, with a small chance of recovery, until last week, when she was very much better until she suddenly became worse on Friday. She was taken to the hospital Saturday with the hope that an operation could save her life. The operation which was performed on Monday was successful, her death being caused by heart failure.

Three years ago Mrs. Young and family moved from Flycreek to Schuyler Lake and during their residence there she made many friends by her kindly disposition and thoughtful ways. She was a member of the Flycreek Chapter, O.E.S. and at one time was Worthy Matron. Her husband is left to mourn the loss of a devoted wife, as are one son, Harry, and an infant daughter Louise; one brother, Hiram Hecox, of Oaksville, and the niece, Miss Bessie Hecox, who has lived with her, besides hosts of friends who mourn her untimely death. She was thirty-five years of age.

The funeral was held Thursday at 1 o'clock at the house, Rev. F. [Frank] O. Hokerk [Universalist] officiating, the Eastern Star service being used.
