Mrs. Frank D. Young Died Suddenly at Greenwood

GREENWOOD, N. Y., Sept. 17.—This community was deeply shocked Friday morning by the announcement that Mrs. Mary Davis Young, 65, wife of the late Frank D. Young had passed away suddenly at 10:45 p.m., Thursday evening. While attending a Methodist church meeting she was stricken with cerebral hemorrhage and became unconscious, remaining so until the end when she passed peacefully away.

Her death removes one of the best known and most highly respected women of this community. She was born at Greenwood on Jan. 2, 1868 where she lived until her marriage to Frank D. Young which took place Dec. 4, 1895. All of their married life was spent in Greenwood. Both were leading and highly respected residents. He died April 10, 1935.

She was a member of the Universalist church but was an active attendant upon the Methodist church of Greenwood and one of its most useful and consecrated supporters. She was also a member of the D.A.R., and the Rebekahs.

She leaves 3 children: Mrs. Harland Knight of Ithaca; Miss Grace Young and Dwight Young of Greenwood; one nephew, James Harvey Goodno of Greenwood.

The funeral was held at 2:30 p.m. Sunday from the home and at 3 from the Methodist church. Rev. Shirley Travis, the pastor, officiated. Burial was made in the Greenwood cemetery.

The bearers were: Supervisor D. D. Baker, E. M. Scribner, John Kreiger, Lawrence Knight, J. Knox Miller, Clarence Webster.

The floral offerings were very profuse, showing the deep affection in which she was held. Over 400 attended the funeral and more would have been present if they could have been crowded into the church.
