Fort Plain—Asa B. Zimmerman, 78, died Friday morning at his home in Nelliston, after being in ill health for the past five years. He was born in the Town of St. Johnsville, June 2, 1866. Mr. Zimmerman was a retired farmer and had made his home in Nelliston for the past 20 years. He was a former justice of the peace in Palatine and election inspector of the town of Minden and a member of the Universalist church.

The survivors are his wife, the former Rowena Bellinger; three daughters, Mrs. Frank [Leta] Baldwin, Mrs. Reuben Failing, Jr., and Mrs. Carlton Byers, all of Fort Plain; one sister, Mrs. Arthur Vedder of Nelliston; and two grandchildren, Tech.
