St. Johnsville

The funeral of the late Charles Zimmerman will be held at the late residence on the River road, on the south side between St. Johnsville and Fort Plain to-day, the Rev. H. W. Carr [Universalist] of Fort Plain officiating. Mr. Zimmerman was a native of Minden, but at one period resided in the Crum Creek neighborhood, north of this place. He was in usual health until almost the moment of his death, which occurred Friday night from heart affection. Mr. Zimmerman was related to the pioneers of the Mohawk valley, being descended from Johan Joost Schnell and Jacob Zimmerman, the original patentees at Snell's Bush. Mr. Zimmerman was aged 74 years and is survived by the following children: Mrs. Ambrose Allen and Mrs. George B. Zimmerman of Crum Creek, Mrs. Fred Walrath of Minden, Mrs. Ada Failing of Fort Plain, and Asa Zimmerman and Miss Jennie Zimmerman, who reside on the home farm. Two brothers also survive, William Zimmerman and Jacob Zimmerman of Minden. Many other relatives reside in Minden, St. Johnsville and Danube. Another brother, Peter Zimmerman, removed from this place to Niagara county in 1865, where his descendants still remain.
