Death of Abram Zoller—

At the home of his sister, Mrs. Walter Lane, of 236 Mary street, Utica, at 6 o'clock yesterday morning occurred the death of Abram D. Zoller of Columbia. The deceased went to Utica four weeks ago for medical treatment, but his condition continued to fail. Death was caused from cancer of the stomach. He was ill four months. Mr. Zoller was born in the town of Columbia 64 years ago, and with the exception of one year spent in Connecticut, has always lived in that township. Thirty-four years ago he was united in marriage with Ellen J. Murtaugh of Frankfort, who survives, [with] one daughter, Mrs. Annabel Jones, two brothers, Marcus Zoller of Columbia and James of Ilion, three sisters, Mrs. Ira Ball of Ilion, and Mrs. Walter Lane and Mrs. Isaac Kinne of Utica, and one granddaughter, Miss Nina Jones. The remains were brought from Utica to his home in Columbia by Undertaker Whiter. Funeral services will be conducted from his late home on Wednesday at 1 p.m. by the Rev. C. E. Bingham [Universalist] of Herkimer, and interment will be made in Armory Hill Cemetery of this village.
