Henry Chauncey Zoller

The death of Henry Chauncey Zoller in his 99th year occurred yesterday morning at 6:30 at the home of his son, James Zoller, on Morgan street. His death was caused from a general breaking down and advanced age. For the past three months at times he had been confined to his bed. Last night his son gave him attention on several occasions and in the morning Mrs. Zoller visited his room where he seemed to be sleeping peacefully. About an hour later he died.

The deceased was born at Ford's Bush, Chenango County, in December, 1815, and resided in that section until 1855, when he moved to Elizabethtown, a few miles southeast of Ilion, where he remained 18 years, and at the death of his wife, 41 years ago, came to this village, where he has since made his home with his son.

In 1842 he was married to Barbara Ann Wilson at Sage Bush. She died 41 yeas ago.

The deceased lived a quiet, simple life, devoting his years to the home life, and among his family and the friends of years standing. His mind was very clear and it was most interesting to hear him tell of events of years ago before the development of the many conveniences of to-day.

He is survived by six children, Marceous Zoller, Abraham Zoller, James Zoller, Mrs. Frank Kinne, Mrs. Ira Ball of Ilion, and Mrs. William Swan of Utica.

The funeral will be held Saturday at 1:30 p.m. Rev. C. E. Bingham [Universalist] of Herkimer will officiate and burial will be made at Ford's Bush.
