Fort Plain—Isaac Zoller 68, life-long resident of the Town of Minden, died at the Amsterdam City Hospital at 11:45 Friday night following an operation.

The body was brought to Fort Plain yesterday morning and the funeral will be held Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Universalist Church. The Rev. Rufus Dix, pastor of the Universalist Church at Dolgeville will officiate. Burial will be in Fort Plain Cemetery.
