Mrs. Juliet Dillenback Zoller, 81, widow of Dr. William Zoller, died Sunday morning at her home in this village after an illness of several weeks.

She was born March 14, 1850, at Brookmans Corners, the daughter of James and Maria Hess Dillenback. Mrs. Zoller had always resided in this section, where she was well known and highly respected by a host of friends who will regret to learn of her death. She was a member of the Fort Plain chapter, D.A.R. and the Universalist church, taking an active interest in both organizations.

Mrs. Zoller was twice married, her first husband being John Zoller and the second Dr. William Zoller, who was for many years a well known physician of this village. He died about 16 years ago.

The survivors are one daughter, Mrs. Mae Diefendorf; one grandson, Victor Z. Diefendorf; two great-grandsons, Robert and Fenton Diefendorf, all of Fort Plain; several nieces and nephews.
