Mrs. Mary J. Zoller Succumbs at Little Falls

Little Falls, Dec. 10.—Mrs. Mary J. Zoller, 87, widow of Jacob Zoller, died Tuesday at her home here after a long period of declining health.

She was born December 9, 1843, a daughter of James and Jane Ann Van Alstine Dygert, one of the foremost families of the Dutchtown section. She was married to Mr. Zoller in June, 1872, and two years later they moved to this city.

Surviving are three sons, John I., Thomas J. and Abraham [Abram] Zoller, county judge and surrogate, and two daughters, Maude J. and Zaida¹ Zoller; also three grandchildren, John Jacob, Sarah and Lewis Zoller.
