Death Yesterday of Mrs. Mary Zoller

Dolgeville, May 4.—Mrs. Mary Zoller died yesterday of paralysis at her home on Helmer avenue, after having been in poor health for several years. She was born in the town of Manheim 75 years ago, her maiden name being Mary Hoover. She spent her early life in Manheim and (58?) years ago was united in marriage to William H. Zoller. The couple were residents of this village for years, Mr. Zoller dying in March, 1902. Mrs. Zoller was a member of the Universalist Church and was highly esteemed. She was tendered a party recently by the ladies of the church, the occasion being her birthday. Three daughters survive: Mrs. Dwight Helmer and Miss Helena Zoller of this village and Mrs. Frank Lawyer of Canastota. The funeral will be held from the Zoller residence at 2 p.m. Saturday, the Rev. M. G. [Milo Garfield] Folsom of the Universalist Church officiating, and interment will be made in the village.
